Creating a foiled / gloss varnished document

If the foil / gloss varnish option is chosen, duplicate your artwork pages.

Page one is the front of the business card and page two is the back of the business card. Page three will be the foiled version of page one and page four will be the foiled version of page two. On the print pages remove everything that is to be foiled /gloss varnished and on the foil pages remove everything that is not to be foiled /gloss varnished.

Make the foiled /gloss varnished areas black only (use the following values for the black C0/M0/Y0/K100).

Make sure everything is placed in the correct positions.

IMPORTANT

Anything beyond the white dotted line will be trimmed off.

Bleed (3mm)

The bleed area extends 3mm beyond the edge of your finished document. Colours and images must extend beyond the edge of the document to prevent unwanted white borders around the edge of your finished document. Note that this 'bleed' will be trimmed during the finishing process so ensure that no important details are set up to print in this area.

Safe Area (5mm)

It is recommended that your artwork is at least 5mm from the edge of the page if it is not meant to bleed off. Printed borders placed too close to the edge of a page may look uneven when the job is trimmed.
